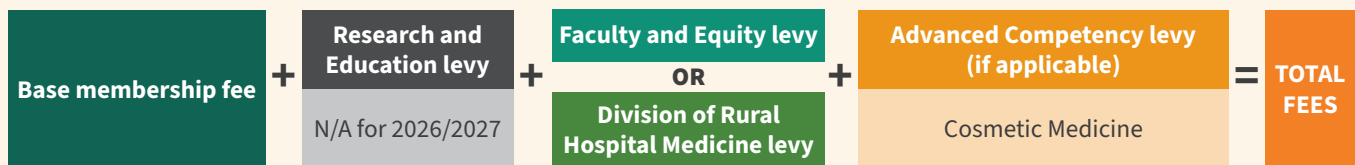




Annual Membership Fees

Part-year membership fees

Membership fees are pro-rated if you join the College or resign part way through our financial year (April to March). Membership is continuous until you formally resign your membership. Should you resign, all outstanding fees, dues and levies must be paid.

Membership Categories

The College has four membership categories:

Fellow (FRNZCGP/FDRHMNZ)

A Fellow has been assessed under the College's Fellowship regulations and is vocationally registered in the scope of general practice or rural hospital medicine.

Registrar (GPEP1 and RHMTTP)

A Registrar (GPEP1 and RHMTTP) is enrolled in GPEP but is yet to pass the College's examinations and/or enrolled in the RHMTTP.

Registrar (Advanced)

A Registrar (Advanced) is enrolled in the College's GPEP programme and has successfully passed the College's examinations.

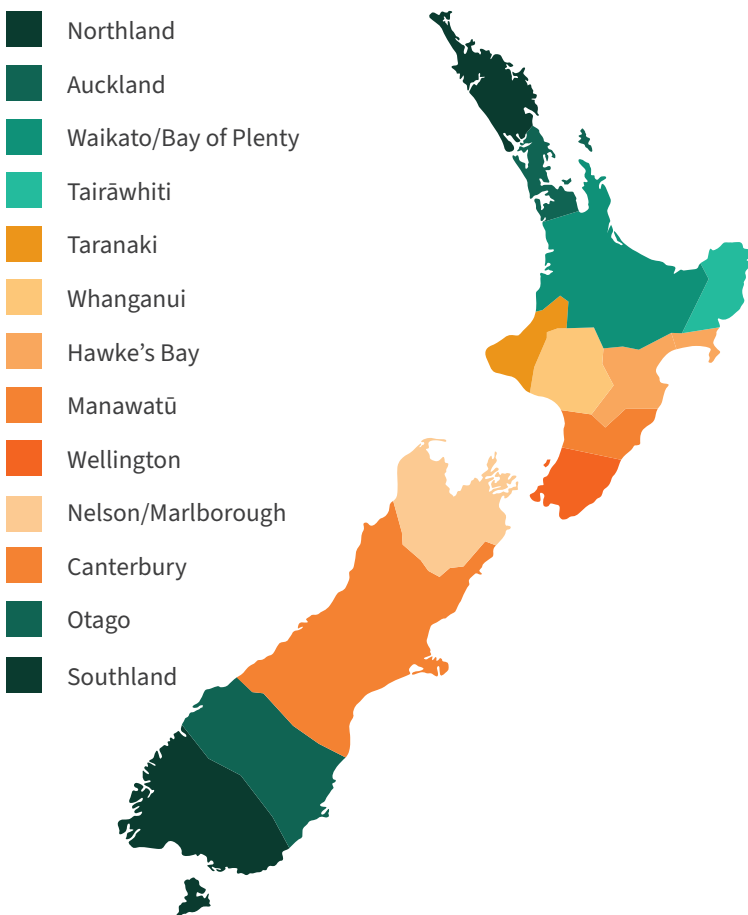
Affiliate

An Affiliate is currently enrolled in GPEP through the PST/VEAB pathway OR a New Zealand-registered doctor engaged in general practice, rural hospital medicine or other aligned scopes.

The College Structure

Faculties

College Faculties are based on geographical areas and allow members to be involved in discussion and decision-making at a regional level. The 13 Faculties from north to south are:



All College members are automatically assigned to a regional Faculty and will receive information about Faculty activities directly.

Chapters

Unlike Faculties, Chapters are groups of members that revolve around major national areas of practice. The four Chapters are:

1. The **Pacific Chapter** made up of members who identify as Pacific, or members who serve communities with large Pacific populations or who are interested in Pacific health issues. Membership of this Chapter is optional.
2. The **Registrars' and Affiliates' Chapter** made up of doctors who are enrolled in the General Practice Education Programme (GPEP) and Division of Rural Hospital Medicine (DRHM) vocational training programmes. Membership of this Chapter is optional.
3. The **Rural General Practitioners' Chapter** made up of College members who are involved in the provision of services within the scope of general practice in rural communities. Membership of this Chapter is optional.
4. The **Division of Rural Hospital Medicine** made up of all DRHM members, who automatically belong to this Chapter.

Te Akoranga a Māui

Te Akoranga a Māui is the College's Māori representative group, made up of College members who identify as Māori and have a Māori whakapapa. Membership is optional.
