



Expression of Interest – Fellowship Assessor Division of Rural Hospital Medicine

The Royal New Zealand College of General Practitioners (the College) is welcoming applications for the role of Fellowship Assessor for the Division of Rural Hospital Medicine (DRHM).

As a DRHM Fellowship Assessor you will support the quality, consistency, and integrity of Fellowship standards by ensuring Rural Hospital Medicine Training Programme (RHMTTP) registrars and DRHM Prior Specialist Pathway doctors have met the required standards for DRHM Fellowship, and are safe and competent to practice independently within the scope of rural hospital medicine.

The Fellowship Assessor assesses whether RHMTTP registrars and DRHM Prior Specialist Pathway doctors have met the required standards for DRHM, and provides fair, consistent, and evidence-informed recommendations to support Fellowship decisions.

Key features of the role

- Assess candidates to determine their ability to meet DRHM Fellowship standards
- Provide fair, consistent, and evidence-informed recommendations and assessment reports to support Fellowship decisions
- Attend Assessor meetings in Wellington
- Training and orientation will be provided

Appointment details

- Contractor role
- Fixed term: 1 year
- Approximately 3-4 visits per year

Applicants must be vocationally registered rural hospital doctors in New Zealand, hold DRHM Fellowship, have a current practicing certificate, and be working in a New Zealand rural hospital.
