



Expression of Interest – Prior Specialist Pathway Assessment Committee Member for Division of Rural Hospital Medicine

The Royal New Zealand College of General Practitioners (the College) is welcoming applications for Prior Specialist Pathway Assessment Committee members for the Division of Rural Hospital Medicine (DRHM).

The Prior Specialist Pathway (PSP) provides individualized pathways to DRHM Fellowship for specialists from New Zealand and specified overseas countries. The Assessment Committee includes a Board of Studies member, a Clinical Lead, and a Fellow representative.

As a Fellow representative of the DRHM PSP Assessment Committee you will consider PSP Evaluator reports on applicants seeking vocational registration in New Zealand in the scope of rural hospital medicine.

Key features of the role

- Consider PSP Evaluator reports and documentation
- Undertake applicant interviews
- Establish individual specific pathway to DRHM Fellowship
- Training will be provided

Appointment details

- Contractor role
- Fixed term: 2 years
- Approximately 5-10 hours per year dependent on volume of applications

Applicants must be vocationally registered rural hospital doctors in New Zealand, hold DRHM Fellowship, have a current practicing certificate, and be working in a New Zealand rural hospital.
